Philly-SIDA Announces 2025 Men's Cross Country Academic All-Area Team; Jacob Dinerman (Rutgers-Camden) Named Performer of the Year

PHILADELPHIA, PA – Earning the title of 2025 Philly-SIDA Men's Cross Country Academic All-Area Performer of the Year, Rutgers University-Camden junior **Jacob Dinerman** (Haddon Township, N.J.) was one of nine student-athletes voted to the Academic All-Area roster. Eight of the nine members are first-time recipients and this year, the typical seven-man roster was expanded to nine due to ties in voting. The Philly-SIDA Academic All-Area teams are nominated for, and voted on, by the sports information offices at 30 regional colleges and universities.

Dinerman's 2025 season hit its zenith with a fourth-place finish (24:43.3) at the NCAA Division III Metro Regional Championships (Nov. 15), and he recorded four of the top six 8K times in program history culminating in a 92nd-place finish (25:14.7) at the NCAA DIII Cross Country Championships (Nov. 22). He was an All-New Jersey Athletic Conference (NJAC) First Team performer for the second year in a row, finishing 12th at the Championships with a time of 26:06.5. Dinerman led the Scarlet Raptors in all nine meets and was a seven-time Raptor of the Week.

Academically, the liberal studies major is a Dean's List student who earned Rutgers University-Camden Athletic Director's Honor Roll recognition for both semesters on campus.

In addition to Dinerman, the 2025 Philly-SIDA Men's Cross Country Academic All-Area Team included Eastern University senior Ryle Mellinger (Glen Mills, Pa.), Gwynedd Mercy University senior Sebastian DeSimone (West Orange, N.J.), Rowan University graduate student Matthew Conway (Haddon Township, N.J.), Swarthmore College junior Cohen Manges (Mechanicsburg, Pa.), Williamson College of the Trades junior Bryan Hernandez (Bridgeton, N.J.), and a trio from Haverford College—senior Micah Lachman (Bethesda, Md.) and juniors Owen Bluman (Pittsburgh, Pa.) and Torin Pelton-Flavin (Newton, Mass.).
