### PLAYER OF THE WEEK

**TRAVIS JOCELYN** • The College of New Jersey  
Senior • Forward • Verona, NJ/Verona

TCNJ's Travis Jocelyn earns his second NJAC Men's Basketball Player of the Week honor of the season after leading the Lions to a sweep of Kean to remain unbeaten. He averaged 23.0 points, 7.5 rebounds, 2.5 assists, and 2.0 steals, while shooting 60.7 percent from the field and 89 percent at the free throw line. Jocelyn went 9-for-17, including three treys, en route to 23 points in Friday night's 74-64 win. He also pulled down seven boards and grabbed three steals. In the second of the home-and-home series on Saturday, Jocelyn went 8-for-11 for another 23-point outing in a 99-77 win over the Cougars. He also pulled down eight rebounds and dished five assists. Jocelyn currently ranks second in the NJAC in scoring (23.8 ppg) and sixth in rebounding (7.2 rpg).



### ROOKIE OF THE WEEK

**GAVIN HENRY** • Rutgers-Camden  
Freshman • Guard • Sicklerville, NJ/Winslow Township

Gavin Henry earns his first NJAC Rookie of the Week honor of the season on the heels of two double-figure-scoring games against 2019-20 conference runner-up Stockton. He averaged 12.5 points, 5.5 rebounds, and 1.5 steals. On Friday, he went 6-for-10 en route to a game-high 14 points in the 82-50 setback. He added a steal and assist each, and committed just a single turnover in 34 minutes on the court. Henry added a team-high-tying 11 points on Saturday, while pulling down a game-high and career-high-tying nine rebounds. The rookie currently leads the Scarlet Raptors in scoring this season (12.0 ppg) and is second on the team in rebounding (5.0 rpg).
